Come November and CODE celebrated its 19th year of existence. Started in November 16, 1991, when the first camp left Mumbai for Pune with a group of 147 girls from the Dadar Parsee Youth Assembly High School.

The Girls camped at Sangam, Allandi Road, Pune ,the International Campsite of the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGS). The Company persisted with camping till March 1997. It became a part of the Magnum Group of Travel Companies in 1998 with a registered office at 10, Henry Road, Colaba, Mumbai



It was in August 1999, when CODE pioneered the Project Tour Product and within a 10 year tenure completed over 100 Project Tours. These tours helped to bring history outside the confines of the

classroom and also gave them an insight into cottage, small scale and heavy industries.

The Company started its International Division in 2006 and has organized tours to the US, Europe (Italy, Spain, Turkey and Greece) Africa (Egypt and Kenya) and the Far East (Singapore and Malaysia) in 2008, the Company had started a month long practical training programme for Tour Leaders.

This month we take you on an environment education tour to Dahanu, Nashik and Karjat. Visit the Warli tribe in their backyard, an organic farm, a wine making factory and a green house are the highlights of this tour

Day 01 : Mumbai – Dahanu

Morning, report at the School at 0600 hours. Leave for Dahanu by road at 0645 hours. Arrive Dahanu and check in at the Hotel. After lunch visit an Organic farm (vermiculture and vermin-composting horticulture and floriculture). Evening at leisure on the beach. Dinner and Overnight at the hotel.

Day 02 : Dahanu

Morning after breakfast : Tribal tour of the Warli Tribe Learn about their culture, agricultural techniques and paintings. After lunch visit the Rural Industries that make handicrafts, promoted by the Maharashtra Government. Dinner & Overnight at the hotel.

Day 03 : Dahanu – Nashik

Morning after breakfast leave for Nashik (191 km) Lunch enroute. Arrive Nashik and visit the the Gargoti Museum (20 Km). Visit the Ice Cream Factory to learn how ice cream is made. Sample a scoop and then check in at the hotel. Dinner and Overnight at the hotel.

Day 04 : Nashik – Karjat.

Morning after breakfast visit a Wine Making Factory and learn the types of wine and the making of wine. Lunch enroute. After lunch leave for Karjat. Arrive Karjat and check in at the hotel. Dinner and Overnight at the hotel.

Day 05 : Karjat

Morning after breakfast leave to visit a plantation that showcases green-house farming. Afternoon visit the famous Kondana Caves. Evening leave for Mumbai by road (km) Arrive School. Group disperse. **Tour ends.**
